Grand Villa Parking

Parking at the Grand Villa Casino can be extremely challenging on event nights, especially for volunteers working the evening shifts. Parking is **FREE on Level 1** in Rogers Place on **non-event nights only**.

There is an Impark lot on the north side of the building which also has free parking for volunteers; but on **event nights**, it will be **PAID PARKING ONLY**. Impark also imposes a surcharge for parking in the north lot when there is an event scheduled. It goes into effect **3 hours** before the event start time. Day shift volunteers should be fine in that lot if they are registered before the surcharge start time.

Count Room volunteers are scheduled to arrive at 11:00pm; so on an event night, they can come in a little bit later in hopes of the event being considered officially over, and may **“possibly”** be able to register for free parking. It will be the evening cash cage volunteers that will have the most difficulty finding free parking.

Volunteers that park in the north Impark lot or on Level 1 of Rogers Place, will need to register their vehicles with Guest Services, which is located inside the casino, right at the top of the escalator as you come inside. They will need to advise Guest Services that they are a volunteer and give them their vehicle license plate number.

Volunteers are of course, free to park anywhere else in the downtown core. If your volunteers pay for parking, regardless of where, they can be reimbursed from your casino account, just be sure to get a receipt. You are not given any extra money to cover parking charges, it is an extra expense that you incur because your casino event is at Grand Villa Casino.

Security will escort volunteers to their vehicles when parked on Level 1 of Rogers Place or in the north Impark lot. They are unable to do escorts to other off-site parking lots.
